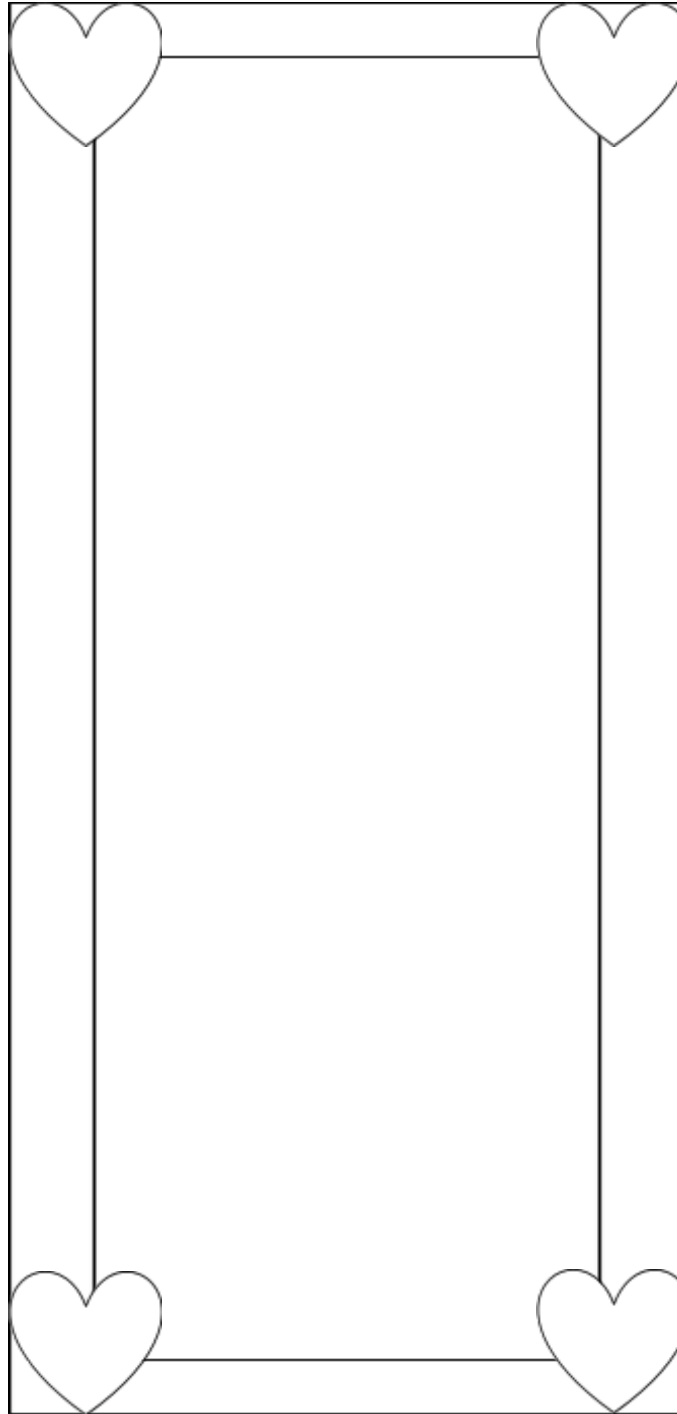

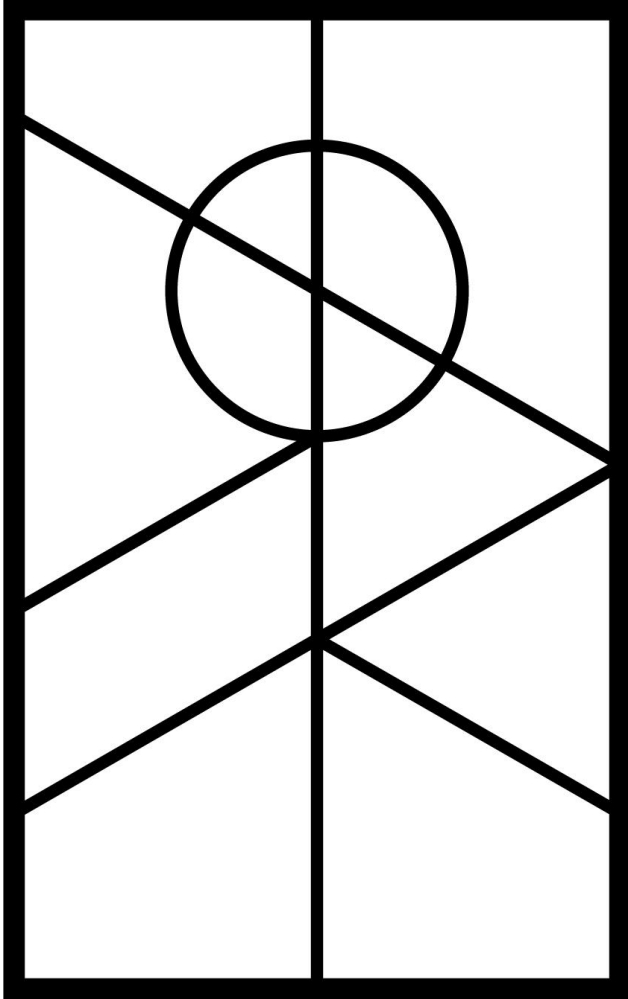

is Baptism?

Baptism is a symbol of our new life in Christ and is one way of showing other people that we are committed to following Jesus. It is a special part of a worship service when someone from the congregation comes forward to have water sprinkled or poured over their head (OR they step into the big trough full of water and actually go all the way under)! Baptism symbolizes that we are dying to our old self. We are lowered down, just like in a grave, just like Jesus after He was crucified. But then, also just like Jesus, we are raised up to new life!
